Subj: ANTI-TERRORISM AND FORCE PROTECTION (AT/FP) DURING INDIVIDUAL  
READY RESERVE MUSTERING STATUS

Ref: (a) MCO 5500.6H

1. Anti-Terrorism and Force Protection (AT/FP) should be a consideration for all military functions and events. Marine Corps Individual Reserve Support Activity (MCIRSA) muster events are no exception. In conducting these events, it is imperative that the Reserve Support Program (RSP)/MCIRSA leadership have a detailed and rehearsed AT/FP plan to ensure the safety of all muster attendees and participants. As the muster events often occur at civilian venues, it is imperative that RSP/MCIRSA AT/FP planning be closely coordinated with local law enforcement agencies and other emergency response providers.

2. It is understood that some RSP Marines are law enforcement personnel or emergency responders in their civilian capacities. These capabilities shall not account for or serve as a part of any AT/FP plan for muster events. This policy shall not be interpreted to prevent appropriate individual actions in response to an imminent threat or emergency.

3. Finally, it is every Marine's responsibility to remain vigilant in identifying potential threats and understanding what actions should be taken once a threat is identified or in the event of an emergency. This includes knowing and understanding the AT/FP plan and the proper steps to notify local authorities in case of an emergency or an identified threat.

4. The AT/FP plan for all MCIRSA musters will be briefed to the CG, FHG at a minimum of seven days prior to the event.
