FORCE POLICY LETTER 09-12

Subj: IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION AND
RESPONSE (SAPR) CAMPAIGN PLAN

1. Purpose. To establish policy for Marine Forces Reserve (MARFORRES) and Marine Forces North (MARFORNORTH) implementing the Commandant of the Marine Corps' (CMC) Sexual Assault Prevention and Response (SAPR) Campaign Plan 2012.
2. Cancellation. This letter will remain in effect until successful completion of the Campaign Plan or when indicated by the appropriate authority.
3. Information. The Sexual Assault Prevention and Response (SAPR) Campaign Plan 2012, located on the Marine Forces Reserve Home web page, [http://www.marines.mil/unit/marforres/Pages/home.aspx#MFR Banner](http://www.marines.mil/unit/marforres/Pages/home.aspx#MFR_Banner) definitively reiterates the Commandants intent to eliminate sexual assault from the Marine Corps. Leaders, at all levels, shall take the assigned task for action.
4. Scope. Phase I of the Campaign Plan includes an aggressive all hands training schedule beginning with a General Officers SAPR Symposium and concludes with a Marine Corps wide all hands one-day training. In order to successfully create a unified and proactive command climate throughout MARFORRES/MARFORNORTH, the following directions and actions are required.
 - (a) "Take A Stand" NCO Training. All Non-Commissioned Officers (NCOs) assigned to MARFORRES/MARFORNORTH are to complete the "Take A Stand" course no later than 31 December 2012.

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(b) Command Team Training (CTT). CTT is for all Command Screened Unit Commanders and Sergeants Major. It will allow all Commanders to receive a consistent SAPR message and ensure that all commanders are prepared to provide the required all hands training to their area of responsibility. Additional information will be disseminated when the conference details are finalized.

(c) All Hands Training. Following the CTT, all commanders shall provide a training plan for the all hands training per the report format provided in enclosure (1) of the SAPR Campaign Plan 2012. Training plans shall be submitted no later than two weeks from the conclusion of the CTT via the respective Major Subordinate Command (MSC) Sexual Assault Response Coordinator (SARC) to the MARFORRES SAPR Program Manager. I recognize that the CMC granted an extended completion date of 30 September 2013; however, it is my intent to fulfill this requirement well before the required date.

(d) Reporting and Tracking. Commanders shall ensure that all training is reported in a timely manner and tracked in the Marine Corps Total Force System (MCTFS). In order to monitor training progress, monthly reports shall be provided by each MSC SARC indicating the numbers and percentage of personnel trained to the SAPR Program Manager in the training report format provided in enclosure (1) of the SAPR Campaign Plan 2012.

5. Certification. This policy is applicable to all MARFORRES/MARFORNORTH military and civilian personnel.
