Subj: STATEMENT OF SUPPORT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE
(DOD) PROGRAM FOR STABILITY OF CIVILIAN EMPLOYMENT

Ref: (a) DoD Instruction 1400.20 of 26 Sep 06

1. The DoD Program for Stability of Civilian Employment, commonly referred to as the Priority Placement Program (PPP), has traditionally provided effective outplacement assistance for DoD civilian employees affected by reduction-in-force (RIF), base closure, consolidations, position classification decisions, rotation from overseas, and transfers of function. This program is a strong unified Defense-wide effort that impacts on recruitment and placement by matching vacancies against the registration of surplus employees.
