Subj: HEADQUARTERS MARINE FORCES RESERVE UNIFORM POLICY

Ref: (a) Mtg with COMMARFORRES dtd 15 June 2005
(b) MARADMIN 412/04

1. Purpose. To establish policy and procedures for the wearing of the Marine Corps Combat Utility Uniform (MCCUU) Woodland Marine Pattern (MARPAT), Desert MARPAT, and the Service Charlie Uniform while in garrison.

2. Cancellation. Force Policy Ltr 8-05.

3. Background. COMMARFORRES direction as prescribed by ref (a) to establish a uniform policy for wear in garrison while aboard Marine Forces Reserve Headquarters New Orleans, Louisiana.

4. Policy

a. Effective as of 1 August 2005, the following uniform policy will apply to all military personnel stationed aboard Marine Forces Reserve Headquarters, and Major Subordinate Command Headquarters, New Orleans, Louisiana.

1) The uniform of the day from the 1st thru the 22nd day of each month will be the Woodland MARPAT Utilities. The woodland camouflage utility uniform is authorized for wear during this period (until phased out).

2) The uniform of the day from the 23rd to the last day of the month will be the Desert MARPAT Utilities.


3) The uniform of the day on the last Friday of each month will be the Service "C" Uniform. For all Navy personnel that are Marine Corps Regs, the uniform of the day on the last Friday of each month will be the prescribed "Summer White" or Khaki.

Subj: HEADQUARTERS MARINE FORCES RESERVE UNIFORM POLICY

4) The dress code for civilian GS and contract personnel remains unchanged. Dress should be casual or business as appropriate for the work being conducted. It should be clean and well maintained.

b. This policy is applicable to all unless otherwise prescribed by the Commander for specific events (e.g. ceremonies, parades) where uniformity is required.

5. Action. Responsible officers and SNCO's will ensure that the guidance of this policy letter is adhered to by all Marines/Sailors within their charge.
