GENTEXT/REMARKS/1. THIS MARADMIN UPDATES THE MARINE CORPS OFFICIAL
ADOPTION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF MRRS AS THE AUTHORITATIVE SOURCE OF
INDIVIDUAL MEDICAL READINESS REPORTING.
2. BACKGROUND. ON 14 JUNE 2005, THE MEDICAL OFFICER OF THE MARINE
CORPS APPROVED THE IMPLEMENTATION OF MRRS AS THE AUTHORITATIVE
MEDICAL READINESS REPORTING SYSTEM FOR THE MARINE CORPS (REF A).
THE MARINE CORPS POSITION WAS FURTHER REINFORCED BY BUMED IN
AUTHORIZING MRRS FOR USE IN BUMED MEDICAL TREATMENT FACILITIES (REF
B). 1 AUG 05, MARFORRES SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED ITS TRANSITION FROM
SHIPBOARD NONTACTICAL AUTOMATED PROCESSING (SNAP) AUTOMATED MEDICAL
SYSTEM (SAMS) TO MRRS (REF C). ON 9 TO 12 JANUARY 2006, HQMC HOSTED
AN ACTIVE DUTY COMPONENT PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTATION CONFERENCE TO
DEVELOP AND BEGIN TO EXECUTE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF MRRS.
3. MRRS PROVIDES COMMANDERS WITH THE CAPABILITY TO RECORD, TRACK,
AND REPORT AGGREGATED MEDICAL DATA AND PROVIDES FULL VISIBILITY INTO
THE INDIVIDUAL MEDICAL READINESS (IMR) STATUS.
4. MRRS IMPLEMENTATION INTO THE ACTIVE DUTY COMPONENT IS CURRENTLY
UNDERWAY. III MEF INITIATED THE MRRS FIELDING PROCESS IN MARCH 06.
THE II MEF IMPLEMENTATION BEGAN IN MAY 06. I MEF, MARCENT (REF C)
AND MARSOC ARE SCHEDULED TO COMPLETE MRRS IMPLEMENTATION BY THE END
OF FY 06.
5. POLICY. OPERATIONAL UNITS ARE DIRECTED TO UTILIZE MRRS FOR ALL
INDIVIDUAL MEDICAL READINESS DATA ENTRY AND REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.
UPON COMPLETION OF MRRS TRAINING, DATA CONVERSION FROM SAMS TO MRRS,
AND VERIFICATION OF RECORDS WITHIN MRRS, SAMS WILL NO LONGER BE
AUTHORIZED FOR UTILIZATION.
6. ACTION
A. OPERATIONAL UNITS
(1) ENSURE ALL UNITS CONDUCT MRRS TRAINING AND IMPLEMENTATION IN
ACCORDANCE WITH TIMELINE ESTABLISHED AT MRRS ACTIVE DUTY PLANNING
CONFERENCE.
(2) MARFOR/MEF/MARCENT/MARSOC AND/OR JOINING FACILITIES WILL ENSURE
ALL MARINES AND ATTACHED NAVY PERSONNEL ARE ASSESSED INTO THE UNIT
DIARY AND MCTFS BY RUC/MCC WITHIN 72 HOURS OF PCS ASSIGNMENT, FAP OR
TAD.
(3) MARFOR/MEF/MARCENT/MARSOC WILL APPOINT ADMINISTRATORS IOT
PROVIDE MRRS IMPLEMENTATION AND PROGRAM OVERSIGHT, SUPPORT TO
SUBORDINATE COMMANDS AND MEET REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR

MARFOR/COCOM COMMANDERS. EACH MSC WILL APPOINT SYSTEM ADMINISTRATORS AT THE BATTALION/GROUP LEVEL TO PERFORM THE FOLLOWING ADMINISTRATIVE FUNCTIONS:

1. ACCESS APPROVAL. THE ADMINISTRATOR WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ASSIGNING ROLES AND PROVIDE ACCESS AUTHORIZATION FOR UNIT DATA VIEW, EDIT, AND REPORT ACCESS FOR SUBORDINATE COMMANDS/UNITS. NON-MEDICAL PERSONNEL WILL HAVE READ ONLY PERMISSION.

2. ACCOUNT MANAGEMENT. THE ADMINISTRATOR WILL SET/RESET/DELETE PASSWORDS AND MAINTAIN A CURRENT LIST OF AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL WITH ACCESS.

3. UNIT RUC AND MCC MAINTENANCE. ADMINISTRATORS WILL ENSURE THAT EACH ASSIGNED UNIT RUC AND MCC IS CURRENT, ASSIGNED TO ORGANIZATION HIERARCHY, AND COORDINATED WITH HQMC/MCTFS VIA MARFORS.

4. PROVIDE GUIDANCE FOR UPLOADING OF SAMS INFORMATION AND TRAINING OF MRRS USERS.

B. SUPPORTING ESTABLISHMENT UNITS WILL INITIATE MRRS CONVERSION COMMENCING FY 07.
