

Achieve and Sustain Force Readiness and Agility








Command Vision for Marine Forces Reserve



The mission of Marine Forces Reserve (MARFORRES) is to provide the Total Force with combat-ready reserve forces, capable of seamlessly reinforcing and augmenting the Active Component. MARFORRES must maintain an agile posture to meet emerging threats while sustaining a lethal and responsive force in a dynamic and contested global environment.

Command Imperatives

Our imperatives are mutually supporting, where success in one enhances success in the others. To effectively gauge our progress, we must establish meaningful assessment criteria. MARFORRES will focus on the following five imperatives to achieve our vision:

IMPERATIVE 1

READINESS

Maintain a force that is proficient, combat-ready and lethal, ensuring we can rapidly activate when needed. This requires us to fill our ranks, both in assistance to ongoing recruiting efforts and retention of Active Component Marines that choose to join the Reserve.

IMPERATIVE 2

AGILITY & FLEXIBILITY

Reimagine force structures and processes to enable swift activation for crisis response. The key to swift activation is ensuring we maintain a high level of readiness to provide flexible force employment options to the service.



INNOVATION & MODERNIZATION

Drive equipment, technology, and training modernization in collaboration with the Active Component to prepare for multidomain operations. Strike a balance of unit modernization and site optimization within current readiness requirements.

IMPERATIVE 4

INTEGRATION & COLLABORATION

Foster deep integration and collaboration with the Active Component by leveraging our unique Reserve strengths to support Total Force training opportunities and operational requirements.

IMPERATIVE 3

PREPARE FOR LARGE-SCALE ACTIVATION

Analyze and improve readiness metrics to facilitate the planning and execution of large-scale activation exercises. Learning, identification of obstacles, and process improvements will be a continued effort.

Strategic Context

The global security landscape demands a force that is not only resilient but also adaptive to rapidly changing threats. Adversaries challenge U.S. interests across all domains, requiring MARFORRES to maintain readiness and integrate fully with joint, allied and partner forces.
