Strategic Environment

The strategic environment is defined by capable adversaries, intensifying competition, and an evolving character of war. The NSS and NDS are clear in prioritizing the defense of the homeland and deterring aggression, particularly in the Indo-Pacific, while relying on capable allies and partners to share the burden of regional security. To be successful, the Joint Force must fight as an integrated network across services and allied nations, with interoperability established before conflict begins. The Commandant's guidance aligns the Marine Corps with this reality through distributed operations, stand-in forces, and deeper integration with allies, while maximizing the RC's potential. Recent combat operations underscore that this guidance is not theoretical. It is being executed in real time. The demand for ready forces, credible deterrence, and capable partners is immediate. For MFR, the Comprehensive Readiness Campaign Plan is clear: *readiness is our relevance*. We must provide predictable Global Force Management support, integrate seamlessly with the AC, and remain prepared to mobilize rapidly. MCAC-B operates within this reality. By integrating with the AC to strengthen partners, improve interoperability, and build access before a crisis, we directly enable deterrence and coalition warfighting alongside allies and the Joint Force.

Command Priorities

Mission: Our mission is to conduct Security Force Assistance across the spectrum of conflict to enable partner capabilities in support of Service and Joint Force requirements worldwide.

Purpose: Our purpose is to build trusted military relationships that strengthen partner lethality and interoperability by assessing, advising, training, and assisting forces to operate effectively alongside Marine and Joint Forces. As a Reserve formation, we also provide strategic depth by integrating with the Active Component, supporting GFM requirements, and preparing for mobilization in accordance with MARFORRES' comprehensive readiness priorities.


Method: We have aligned our efforts to the MARFORRES Campaign Plan's Lines of Effort to ensure unity of purpose and measurable readiness. Our priorities are:


- Support Combatant Commanders through predictable GFM sourcing and activations
- Integrate seamlessly with the Active Component through exercise support
- Mobilize at scale quickly and effectively
- Continue to institutionalize the advisor capability across the Marine Corps

End State: MCAC-B is a ready, integrated, and mobilization-capable advisor formation.
